Addendum to Subcontract.

The Subcontract, together with the Prevailing Wage Addendum, obligates Subcontractor to comply with the Prevailing Wage Laws of the State of California, Labor Code Section 1771, et seq., and requires Subcontractor to indemnify and defend General Contractor from any and all liability, obligations, costs, damages, losses and expense, including attorneys' fees incurred by General Contractor as a result of Subcontractor's failure to comply with the Prevailing Wage Laws of the State of California.

Pursuant to the Subcontract, as set forth in the Prevailing Wage Addendum, final payment to Subcontractor is conditioned upon Subcontractor providing to General Contractor an affidavit signed under penalty of perjury, that Subcontractor has paid the specified prevailing rate of per diem wages to Subcontractor's journeymen, apprentices, workers and other employees employed by Subcontractor in connection with the Project, and any amounts due pursuant to Labor Code Section 1813.

NOW, THEREFORE, the undersigned states as follows:

1. Subcontractor has submitted to General Contractor during the course of the Subcontract certified payroll reports which set forth the name, social security number, straight time, overtime hours worked each day, and the actual per diem wages paid to each journeyman, apprentice, worker or other employee employed by Subcontractor in connection with the Project.

2. The information contained in the certified payroll reports submitted by Subcontractor to the General Contractor is true, correct and complete for the Project in its entirety.
3. Subcontractor has paid the wages to each journeyman, apprentice, worker or other employee employed by Subcontractor in connection with the Project, as shown in the Subcontractor's certified payroll reports submitted to General Contractor, including any benefits due to the applicable union trust fund.
4. Subcontractor has fully and completely complied with the requirements of Labor Code Sections 1771, 1775, 1776, 1775.5, 1813 and 1815, together with any other provisions of the Prevailing Wage Laws of the State of California, Labor Code Section 1771, et seq. Subcontractor has paid the specified general prevailing rate of per diem wages to Subcontractor's employees on the Project and any amounts due pursuant to Labor Code Section 1813.
5. I have read this Affidavit and know the contents thereof. The same is true of my own knowledge.
